WELCOME TO YEAR 7

Students are part of a tutor group based in a dedicated Year 7 area where their tutor will get to know each of them on a personal basis. They can expect a culture of high expectations, praise and reward and being stretched and challenged in their learning from day one. There are many opportunities for students to develop their independence as well as for group learning and personal development starting with a comprehensive week-long transition programme in the summer term before they arrive. This is very popular with students and parents alike, giving a fantastic springboard into secondary education. In year 7, students feel confident and valued and are rewarded for their hard work.

STARTING IN OTHER YEAR GROUPS

If your child joins us part way through the year they will receive the same warm welcome as our new year 7s. They will be placed in a tutor group with other students in the same year and their tutor will arrange a 'buddy' to help them settle in.

PRACTICAL CONSIDERATIONS

GETTING TO SCHOOL

School buses run from Kneesall, Old Clipstone, Kirton, Edwinstowe, Newark, Mansfield, Eakring, Walesby and Bilsthorpe. To find out whether your child is entitled to free transport, please contact Nottinghamshire County Council. The school also provides drop-off points and bicycle parking.

AFTER SCHOOL ACTIVITIES

The Dukeries Academy provides a range of after school activities. A free minibus runs after school at 4.30 from Monday to Thursday to enable your child to take part.

UNIFORM

Our students are expected to dress smartly and take pride in their appearance. All students in years 7 to 11 are required to wear the academy uniform, which includes our new house ties. Shoes, hairstyle, plus any makeup and jewellery must also comply with expectations, which can be found on our website. In the sixth form there is a dress code of smart business wear.

OUR CURRICULUM

FROM YEAR 7

When your child joins The Dukeries Academy in year 7, they will study a broad range of subjects, including: English, mathematics, science, ICT, physical education, personal social & health education and citizenship, geography, history, religious education, technology, drama, art, music and French.

ONWARDS AND UPWARDS

As our students progress towards options in year 9 and for sixth form our aim is to give our students the qualifications and skills necessary to follow the career pathway of their choice.

Options subjects are organised into a number of learning routes to ensure our students follow courses that best meet their needs and they go on to achieve the highest standards. There are three learning routes and within them there are a wide range of subject choices. These routes will enable students to tailor their studies based on their abilities and aspirations, whether they wish to study the English Baccalaureate or follow a more vocational route.

POST 16

Our post 16 centre offers a personalised experience for all of our students whilst maintaining a broad and balanced curriculum offer. We are able to provide a comprehensive number of Level 3 qualifications for students on both academic and vocational pathways. If a subject is offered at GCSE/Vocational level then we will aim to provide that subject in our post 16 centre.

Although academic achievement is at the core of what we do, we believe that school should be about more than just passing exams.
