Cleaning to take place at break time and lunch time, in addition to the usual morning and after school slots. This cleaning rota was already timetabled before we were asked to move to classroom lessons. Where there is an issue with cleaning at lunch times due to split lunches cleaning will take place during lesson change overs. Students will not be allowed access to the department during break and lunch time due to cleaning procedures. Hand sanitisers must be kept filled. Lidded bins for disposal of waste to be used to avoid spread of any germs. Windows and doors kept open when possible to allow ventilation. No sharing of scripts is permitted. Any short scripted scenes will be projected for students to read from. No props or costumes to be used. 		
Practical Drama lessons	Staff Students	Spread of COVID 19 / illness	 Whilst government guidelines do not call for social distancing between students in year group bubbles, social distancing between staff members and students must be maintained during all drama lessons. Use the innovation room instead of the rehearsal space as this is larger and easier to socially distance. Warm ups/drama games/exercises will be socially distanced, with no contact games allowed. Students will be reminded that when they are rehearsing/performing there is to be NO PHYSICAL CONTACT between them. No shouting/chanting/singing during warm ups, rehearsals or performances. Students encouraged to rehearse side to side instead of face to face. Students will be allocated a group for group work at the start of the term. They will work in this group 	LOW	N

First aid / medical emergency	Staff Student	Spread of COVID 19 / illness	for all lessons. The space will be divided up to ensure that each group has their own space to work in. Students will not be able to move into another groups space. • When the weather allows rehearsals and lessons will be taken outside (area behind the Theatre and behind the Rehearsal space) • When watching others perform students must form a socially distanced audience and the performers must remain 2 metres from the audience. • Hand sanitiser will be available during the lesson but must be used at the end of every lesson. • If a student requires first aid staff will call on-call who will co-ordinate any first aid requirements • Should a student require immediate first aid, full PPE MUST be worn by staff member including gloves, face mask, apron, visor (if appropriate) • Ensure hand sanitising/washing is a priority for both the student and staff member
