## Re: Academy closure update

I hope you and your family continue to be safe and well during this exceedingly challenging time.

I am writing to you following the Prime Minister's speech on Sunday 10 May 2020 and the subsequent guidance for schools which was released yesterday evening. At the current time there has been **no change** to the guidance for secondary schools. We will, therefore, continue to offer daily provision for children of key workers and children identified as vulnerable by the government.

I will be working with colleagues at the Academy and Academy Transformation Trust to fully review these new guidance documents and develop robust plans which will allow us meet the expectations set out by the government for provision after 1 June 2020; 'secondary schools and colleges to offer some face to face support for children and young people in year 10 and year 12 to supplement their remote education'.

The health, safety and well-being of our students and staff will be central to any plans we make. I can assure you that we will only re-open The Dukeries Academy when I am satisfied that we can, as far as possible, minimise risk. I will update you on the progress of our planning next week.
