3 Addressing The Needs Of Each Pupil	Opportunities for advice and support are given to each pupil, the careers hub can be accessed at lunchtime or you can ask for a careers interview via email careers@dukeies.attrust.org.uk . Or twitter @CareersDukeries
4. Linking Curriculum Learning To Careers	All teachers link curriculum learning with careers. STEM subject teachers highlight the relevance of STEM subjects for a wide range of career paths. Tutors and subjects will take part in a week of activities for National Careers Week.
5. Encounters With Employers and Employees	Every pupil has multiple opportunities to learn from employers about work, employment and the skills that are valued in the workplace. This is though range of enrichment activities including visiting speakers, mentoring, Pixl Edge, Unifrog and enterprise schemes.
6 Experiences Of Workplaces	Every pupil should have first-hand experience of the workplace through work visits, work shadowing and/or work experience to help their exploration of career opportunities, and expand their networks. In year 10 and 12.

8 Personal Guidanc	Every pupil should have opportunities for guidance interviews with a career adviser, who is qualified to level 6, this advice should be impartial. These are available in year 9,11,and 12. These are for all pupils they are timed to meet their individual needs.
