

Well done to Isaac in Year 8, who has been invited to the UKMT Junior Mathematical Olympiad following an outstanding performance on the first stage of the UK Junior Maths Challenge last month.

Out of approximately 275000 participants each year, only 1200 are selected for this elite-level mathematics competition: this means that Isaac falls within the top 0.4% of students in his age group in the whole of the UK!
