**Re: Year 10 Mock Examinations**

Your child will sit mock examinations the week beginning 14 June 2021. To support students in preparing for their mock examinations, I have enclosed a copy of our mock examination timetable.

All examinations will take place during usual timetabled lessons and will be sat in exam conditions in our Concert Hall. Art and Photography mock examinations will follow week beginning 21 June 2021.

It is crucial that all students are in school for all mock examinations so that we are able to provide them with feedback on their target areas to ensure they are fully prepared for future examinations.

Please could you reinforce the following points at home with your child:

- They should attend all mock examinations and should arrive to school for 8.35am to ensure that they are on time
- Students should have all the relevant equipment for exams, including: pens, pencil, ruler, protractor, compass and calculator. Students can also ask their tutor for basic equipment.
- Expectations during exams such as being silent whilst lining up for exams and in the exam hall, no labels on water bottles, clear pencil case and no electronic devices such as mobile phone and smart watches must be adhered to.

We understand that mock examinations can be a stressful time for your child. If you have any concerns about your child's well-being or mental health please don't hesitate to contact me. At the Academy, we are fortunate to have a range of strategies that may help.

Your child will be provided with a booklet, which will contain a list of topics that they need to revise. They will also have a personalised exam timetable that will show them which exams they have each day, along with their seat number.
