Re: The Dukeries Academy Summer School

We are writing to confirm the final details of TDA Summer School, which will be running from Monday 2 August – Friday 6 August 2021.

Our program will include a mixture of exploring the school, fun physical activities and academic preparation, so a pencil case will still be needed most days. We would recommend bringing a small bag each day for their personal belongings.

We will be providing a packed lunch each day, but your child will need to bring their own water bottle that they can re-fill throughout the day. Please use the following link to order food for your child and let us know of any allergies or issues by **Tuesday 27 July 2021**:

Uniform is not expected to be worn during the Summer School, but sensible clothing for the weather would be appreciated. On Tuesday, we will be doing sports in the afternoon so PE attire is required (trainers, shorts/joggers, loose t-shirt etc.) and on Thursday we will be doing outdoor adventures at Walesby Forest so please dress appropriately. We would also recommend a hat and sun cream for these days.

The Summer School will start at 9.00am each morning. Please arrange transport for your child and drop them off outside Reception. A member of staff will be there to meet and greet. They will then be escorted by another member of staff to the classrooms for registration.

Pupils will need to be collected from Reception at the end of each day:

- Monday – 3.00pm
- Tuesday – 3.00pm
- Wednesday – 3.00pm
- Thursday – 4.00pm from Walesby Forest Scout Camp OR 4.30pm from The Dukeries Academy
- Friday – 3.00pm

On Friday 6 August at 2.00pm, we will be having a celebration even in our Concert Hall, which you are welcome to attend. There is no need to book for this just arrive at Reception before 2.00pm on Friday and we will escort you to your seat. Could we ask you to limit attendance to two adults per student please.

Although we want this to be as fun an experience for your child as possible, we would like to reiterate our high expectations of behaviour and standards. We will have support available throughout the week for any student that needs additional support, but we trust you will support us in maintaining a positive working atmosphere for all.
