### **Year 11 Parents' Evening Thursday 9 December 2021**

On Thursday 9 December 2021 we will be hosting our Year 11 Parents' Evening which will take place in our Academy. Appointments will run in person from 3.45pm - 6.00pm. This is an excellent opportunity for you to discuss your child's progress and mock examination results with each of their teachers. During the event, your child's teachers will also share with you information about their engagement in lessons and any upcoming deadlines and assessments.

Your child is currently in the process of receiving free revision guides for subjects where these are available in order to support their exam preparation at home. In addition to this, when you attend Parents' Evening, you and your child will receive a pack containing:

- A book for parents which contains support and guidance for yourselves during exams
- A book for students which advises them on the best ways to approach their revision
- Materials to use for revision such as pens and a pack of flash cards

You will also receive a folder which you can use to collect revision materials from each subject, along with personalised checklists from each subject of what your child should spend more time revising from the mock exam. We hope that these materials will support both yourself and your child in preparing for their second mock examination and subsequent final examinations.

Prior to 9 December, you will be required to book appointments with each of your child's subject teachers.
