Re: Sixth form Progress Review Evening

This letter is to remind you that the Year 12 and Year 13 Progress Evening is on Thursday 2 February 2023. The appointment booking system will open on Thursday 26 January 2023 and remain open until 12.00pm on Wednesday 1 February.2023.

Should you have any problems booking your appointments via the booking systems, please contact our reception staff who will be able to support with the booking of your appointments.

These meetings will provide you with essential information on how your child is doing, and how you can best support them in the run up to the exams. Prior to the evening, you will also have received a copy of their latest progress report, so it will also provide you with an opportunity to ask any questions you may have around this.

For the video appointments, you will need an electronic device with camera and microphone capabilities (such as a laptop, tablet or smartphone) alongside a broadband connection or mobile telephone connection with data.

Prior to your first appointment on the day, you will need to have returned to the link for your appointments. When you log back in, your appointments will be available, and you can select them at the appropriate times throughout the evening. Please note that each appointment will be **five minutes** long and the software will end this once the timer reaches zero. This is important as it ensures that all students and their families have an opportunity to discuss their progress. If anything becomes unclear throughout the event which requires more than this length of time to discuss, please arrange with the teacher another opportunity to discuss further.

We recommend that you optimise your bandwidth on the evening to ensure that the video call is the best possible quality. If you are using a broadband provider, we recommend that all other devices which make use of the bandwidth are switched off. This includes other laptops, tablets or phones not being used for the video call, smart CCTV or doorbells, and Smart TVs. By turning these off, you prevent the dilution of the bandwidth and ensure that the call is the best quality that you can. We also recommend that you either use an ethernet cable where possible, or remain close to your WIFI router if you are using wireless. If you are using a mobile phone network provider then we recommend that you find the optimum location within your house to get the best reception.
