**Re: Teachers' Strike: 1 March 2023**

Following my letter last week, I am writing to provide an update on arrangements for the strike on Wednesday 1 March 2023. The Academy will be open, as normal, to students in Years 7, 11, 12 and 13. In addition, the Academy will also be open to vulnerable students in all year groups – you will have already been contacted by your child's pastoral team if they fall into this group. Mock examinations will go ahead as planned. Students in Years 8, 9 and 10 will work from home.

**Accessing home learning**

- Work for students in Years 8-10 will be set on Class Charts. If your child has forgotten their username or password or needs any support, please email [support-duk@attrust.org.uk](mailto:support-duk@attrust.org.uk) where they will be able to reset the password/support them with ICT issues.

Some work will be using online learning platforms SENECA and SPARX Maths. Students can log in as follows:

- SENECA – Click on the 'Login with Microsoft account' button and input your child's school email address and password (just as they would login to a school computer on site). Email addresses are formatted using their username just like the example here; [BloggsJ22-DUK@attrust.org.uk](mailto:BloggsJ22-DUK@attrust.org.uk)
- SPARX Maths – Students should use their usual login as they do with home learning to access this.
