Re: Revision and Intervention Sessions – Non-Attendance

Our mission as an Academy is to **“transform lives by inspiring excellence and maximising opportunities for all”**. As part of this, we offer our Year 11 students the best possible chance of getting great outcomes, by offering targeted revision sessions.

Unfortunately, your child has not been attending their revision sessions, which run Tuesday – Friday for 45-60 minutes after school, or on selected lunchtimes. These sessions are focusing on exam skills, and the vital knowledge that your child needs to improve on their mock mark and as they move towards their final exams. By not attending these sessions, your child is putting themselves at risk of not achieving the best outcomes possible.

Students were told that they must attend a minimum of two sessions a week, or these will be made compulsory. Starting from 6 March 2023, your child will now be directed to two sessions a week, which they must attend. Failure to attend these sessions will be treated as truancy, and a sanction imposed.

A late bus will run each day to ensure that students are able to get home.
